OPPORTUNITIES:

- Opportunity for sustained conversation on church-related higher education at LFP conferences, events, and in LFP publications.
- Opportunity for you or your school to apply for LFP grants for:
 - Mentoring Programs
 - Network Exchanges
 - Regional Conferences
 - Small Grants
 - Summer Seminars for College Teachers
- Opportunity for both Campus Representatives to attend the LFP National Conference; registration, lodging, and food are free; representatives pay only for travel.
- Opportunity for representatives who are senior administrators to attend the annual Workshop for Senior Administrators free of charge (travel reimbursement up to \$600).
- Opportunity for you or members of your campus to attend LFP Network Exchanges, Regional Conferences, or Summer Seminars for College Teachers at reduced rates or free of charge.
- Opportunity to nominate up to three undergraduates from your institution for the Lilly Graduate Fellows Program.
- Opportunity to network with representatives and members of other LFP network schools at LFP conferences, in service to the LFP, and in communication networks.
- Opportunity to nominate a member of your faculty for the biennial Arlin G. Meyer Prize.
- Opportunities for service in the LFP as referees, as selection committee members for LFP awards and projects, or as a member of the National Network Board.

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RESPONSIBILITIES:

- **Attend** the LFP annual National Conference.
- **Oversee**
 - The nomination process of up to three undergraduates from your institution for the Lilly Graduate Fellows Program.
 - The nomination of a faculty member at your campus for the biennial Arlin G. Meyer Prize and communicate the call for nominations for the biennial LFP Book Award.
- **Encourage**
 - Faculty and administrators at your institutions to apply for LFP grants.
 - Senior administrators to attend the annual LFP Workshop for Senior Administrators.
 - Participation by faculty and administration in LFP activities on your campus or in your region.
- **Communicate**
 - To faculty and administrators at your campus
 - (1) opportunities to attend LFP Conferences, Workshops, and Exchanges
 - (2) the activities of the LFP by passing on: brochures; the *_LFP Update_*, the electronic newsletter of the LFP, and LFP publications—in short, keeping your campus aware of its membership in the LFP.
 - With the other LFP representative at your campus about LFP responsibilities and representation.
 - To the LFP office changes in Representatives, campus enrollment, addresses, e-mail addresses, phone numbers, and presidents or chief academic officers.
 - With your President and the LFP Office regarding payment of annual dues (the LFP office corresponds directly with the president's office at your institution regarding dues payment and will copy you on this correspondence).
