One participant from each school will be reimbursed for travel costs up to \$600. Meals and hotel accommodations will also be paid by the Lilly Fellows Program in Humanities and the Arts. Additional participants from member schools will be waitlisted until September 7, 2016 and will be enrolled as slots become available.
